1. DIRECTOR'S RECOMMENDATION RE: SIGNATURE FOR I.A. w/ EPA IS TO DELEGATE TO SD
2. SOL IS LOOKING AT HOW FAR THE DELEGATION CAN GO. SOL WOULD PREFER SIGNATURE AUTHORITY IN W.O.
3. BERNIE IS PROPOSING AN INTERAGENCY TASK GROUP AT FIELD LEVEL FOR CONFLICT RESOLUTION BEFORE RAISING ISSUES TO W.O. (BLM SD; BuREC REGIONAL DIRECTOR)
