\$40,000 A position is necessary to insure adequate interagency coordination with at least eight agencies and two counties, document review, and general project management for the "Atlas Mine" Superfund site. This particular site, which will be dealt with on an areawide basis, is extremely complex in nature and needs a full time staff person to insure that the Bureau's interests are taken into account during the current assessment and any future remedial actions in the next few years. The areawide approach expands the site so as to include as many as 100 mines and recreational use in the areas.

\$65,000 Various contracts for technical assistance to provide inputs into "Atlas Mine" Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study, including separate task items for BLM to address the areawide aspects of the total asbestos problem.

The \$65,000 would include numerous separate discrete contracts to provide the above information as it is deemed necessary over the remaining fiscal year. Input will be required from the Bureau and/or their consultants, immediately, during alternative formulation and during the preparation of the feasibility study which is due to be completed by July 88.
